



JOB TITLE: Avionics Technician

Primary Focus

The technician is responsible to the Avionics Manager / Project Manager to ensure that tasks assigned are carried out in accordance with Repair Station Manual procedures and manufacturer specifications. Each technician will be properly certified in accordance with FAR Part 145.151 in order to perform maintenance, preventative maintenance and alterations.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities (fundamental job duties):

- Be thoroughly familiar with the contents of the Repair Station Manual and the Quality Manual.
- Perform tasks as assigned by the Avionics Manager, Lead Technician and/or Project Manager.
- Ensure all tasks assigned and completed conform to industry standards, as well as WCAM Manual procedures.
- Comply with all safety, efficiency and quality standards, including HAZMAT and OSHA.
- Maintain shop equipment and tooling.
- Maintain personal appearance and uniforms to company standards.
- Tow/relocate aircraft within the hangar and ramp area, as required, and utilizing established safety and operational procedures.
- Keep the shop, work spaces, and aircraft work area clean and organized.
- As directed by Avionics Manager, Lead Technicians and Project Managers.

Competencies/Skill-Sets Required:

- Strong communication skills (oral), listening skills, ability to ask questions.
- Independent decision-making, problem solving and analytical skills.
- Accurate and efficient in completion of duties.
- 3 Years minimum experience in FAR PART 145/135 environment
- Computer skills.

Designations/Training required/Prerequisites:

- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Must be highly organized and detail oriented.
- Accountable, trustworthy and dependable.
- Valid driver's license without infractions over the past three years.
- Must be comfortable working as part of a team for the benefit of the entire group
- Must be able to interpret wiring diagrams and electrical schematics
- Must have experience on installations / troubleshooting and understanding of avionics / electrical systems, operations and interfacing
- Must be able to strip, splice and crimp wires and coaxial cables
- A flexible weekly schedule, including evenings and weekends, maybe required.
